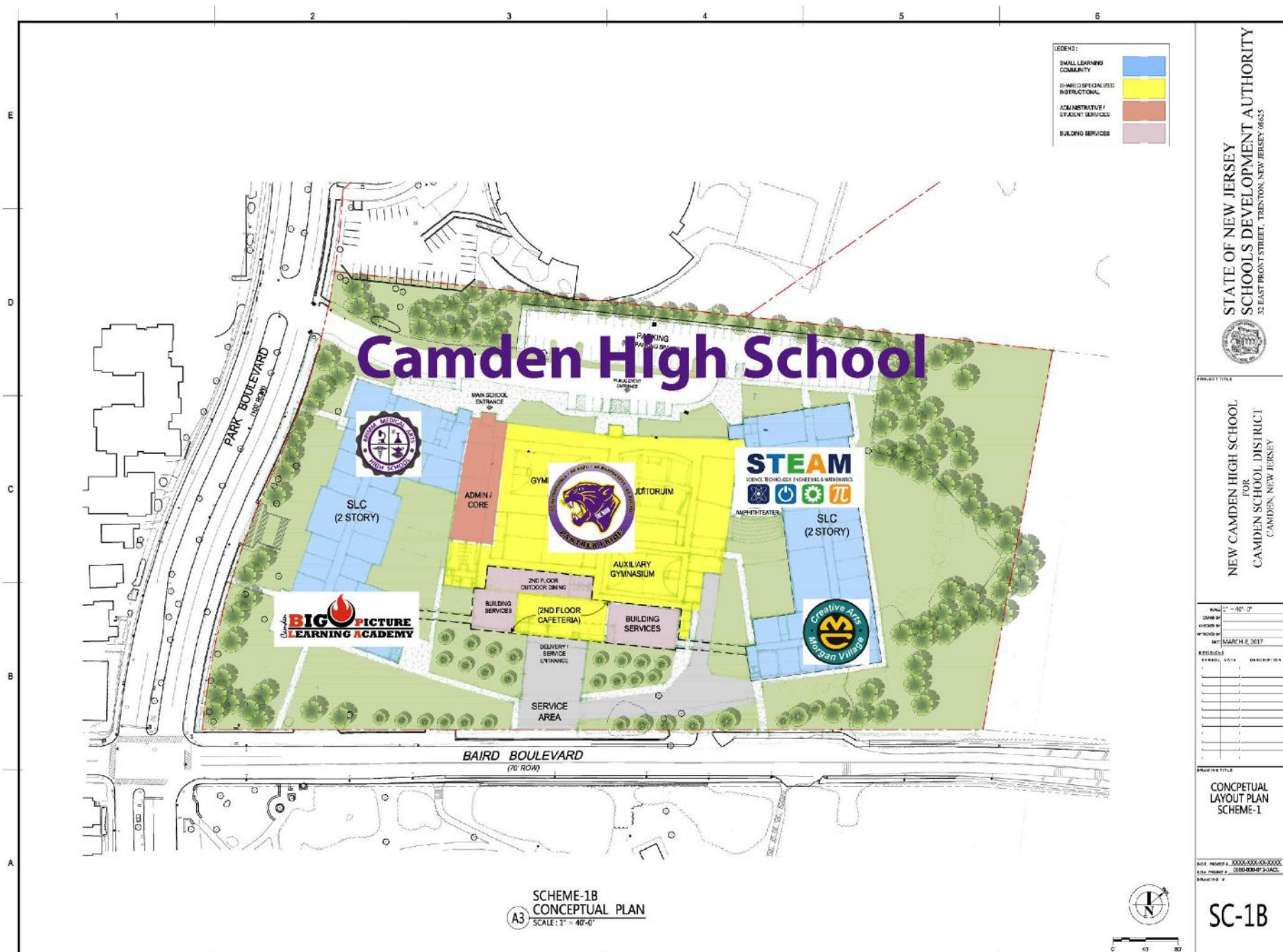

CHS Update: Including CAMVA in the New Camden High

After being suggested by Committee Members, the District believes moving CAMVA into the new Camden High building makes sense for the following reasons:

1. Current building not constructed for a high school arts program
2. New building would be constructed for a high school arts program
3. Many CAMVA students already participate in Camden High activities

The CAMVA building would keep its middle school grades and could develop in to a middle school feeder program with an emphasis on arts education.

CHS Update: Including CAMVA in the New Camden High

If CAMVA moved in to the new Camden High building, students would be able to access the following features:

1. Black box theater
1. Textiles studio
1. Dance studio with bars and mirrors
2. Auditorium with pit orchestra and dressing rooms
3. Music practice rooms connected to a recording booth

The District will look to the school community throughout the course of the project for feedback on these and other features.

- Hosted at ECDC and local providers
- Registration completed separately beginning May 1

- Students will have the opportunity to participate in Literacy and Math activities in the morning, then select clubs of their choice in the afternoons.

Credit Recovery & Exposure Courses

- Monday, July 10 to Friday, August 4
- 8:30am-12:30pm
- Hosted at WWHS
- Shuttle from Parkside area
- Breakfast provided at 8:00am
- Online course options available for graduation requirement areas

For students:

- Rising 7th through 12th graders (current 6-12)
- Interested in retaking a core content course that they didn't pass or for focused attention in one content area
- Interested in taking a course for exposure to advanced topics

Summer Bridge @ Magnets

- Students will be invited to school specific programs
- Varying dates July 10 to August 4

For students:

- At magnet schools, rising 6th or 9th graders or new students
- Accepted to Brimm, CBPLA, or CAMVA

SPOTLIGHT: Credit Recovery & Exposure Courses

- Students will be completing coursework on the software program Odysseyware to fulfill graduation or promotion requirements or take an advanced course for exposure.
- Students will be responsible for completing all course work by end of the program, but can be self-paced.

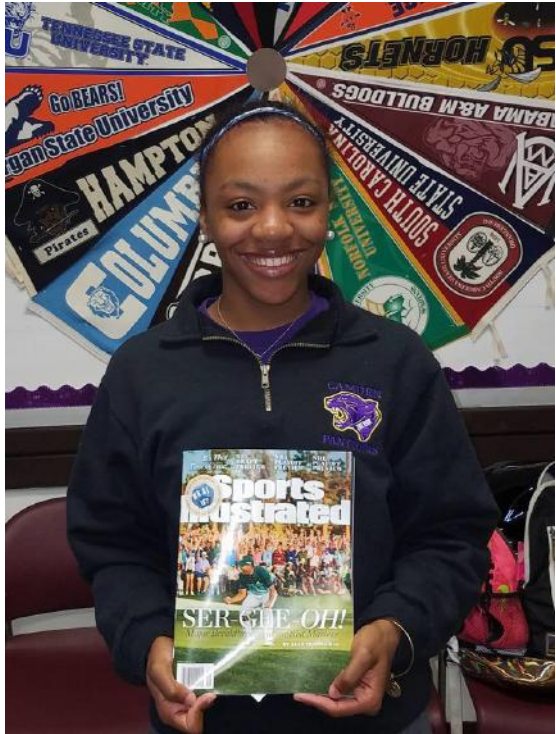
