

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FDOS Readiness: Staffing

- Welcome to 71 new school-based staff members!
- Teacher vacancy rate < 4% for FDOS
 - Including Leaves of Absence
- New training and supports for all substitutes and long term subs
- Kids will know their teacher on day one



FDOS Readiness: Technology

- All K-5 classrooms have at least 5 desktops ready
- High school ELA/Math classes have at least desktops in each classroom
- Additional smartboards installed and repaired across the District
- New copiers installed to deliver secure and efficient teacher printing
- 1:1 student: device ratio for Summit Learning programs


