- Standards Mastery Quizzes begin mid November

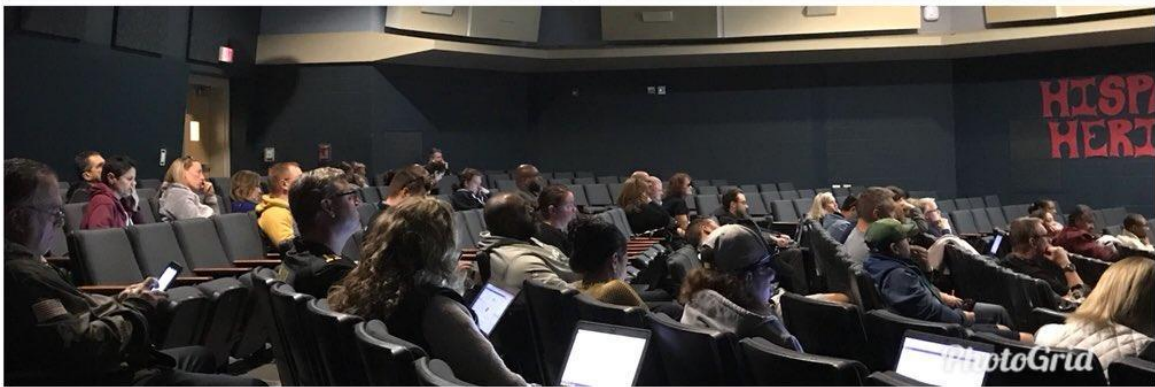
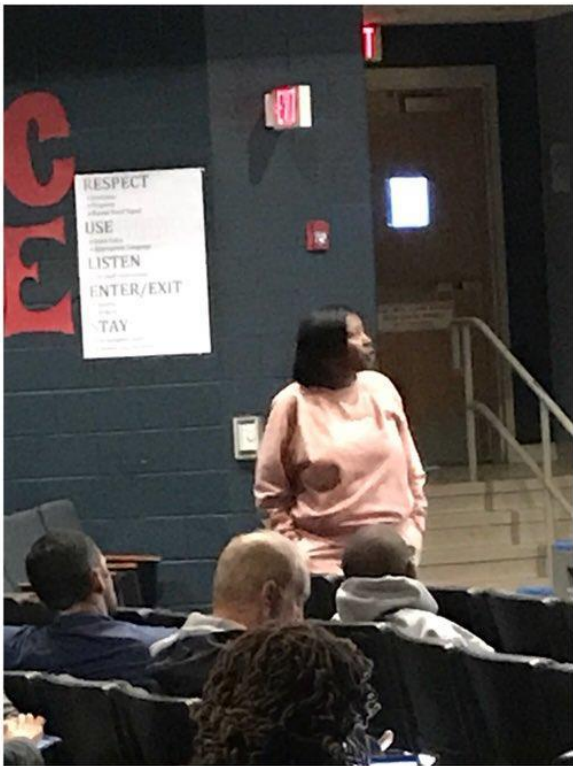
