

- 6 schools need critical structural / envelope repairs

- Electrical, plumbing, HVAC, and mechanical needs
- Roof and building envelope





# Instruction & Program

- **Increase student learning:** decrease the number of students below grade-level, increase student growth and grade-level proficiency
- Curriculum planning: teacher led modifications based on best practices and proven strategies
- Decrease chronic absenteeism: decrease number of students missing more than 18 days a year
- Graduation rate: increase number of students graduating each year

- Audit Findings: Develop and implement an Corrective Action Plan (CAP) to overcome audit findings

  internal controls are in place
- Training: Providing trainings for staff and introduce accountability measures
- Staffing: Hire an Assistant Business Administrator and other vacancies

 Health and Safety Evaluation: Abate and have the fire marshal reinspect all infractions in the 100% compliance categories on the Facilities Checklist


