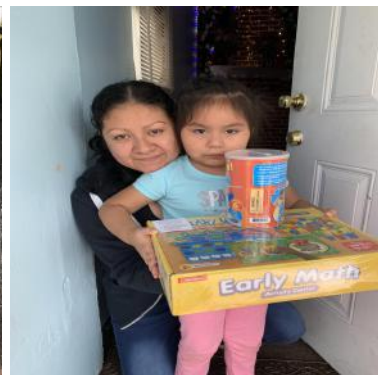
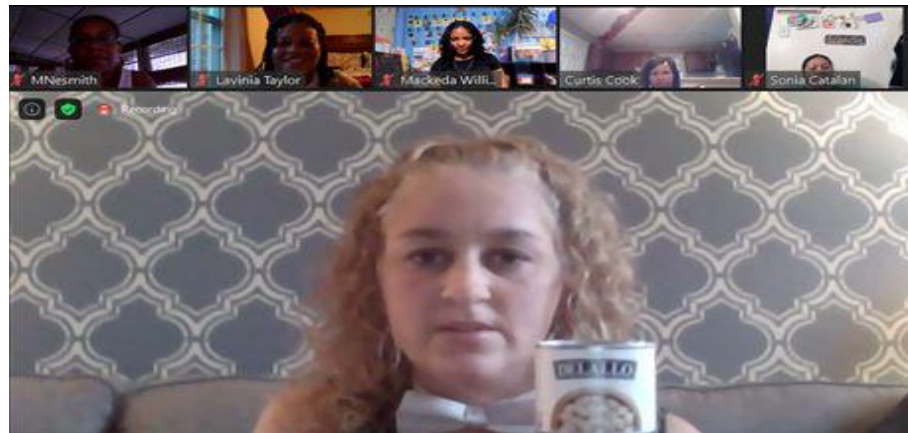




# District Highlights: Annual Preschool Night

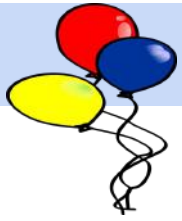
