District Highlights



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Accelerating Student Achievement

District CTE (Career and Technical Education) Department has released the CTE Program Guide to 8th Grade Counselors and Child Study Teams to aid families in the school choice process. The district offers 16 different labor market aligned pathways that offered industry recognized credentials upon graduation.

In December 2019, only one district program was State approved. We have since worked to ensure district programming was aligned to State Perkin's regulations.

State Approved Programs of Study: Partnered with a Post-Secondary Institution.

Cisco, Construction Trades, Engineering (New Program), Automotive Trades, Teaching/Education(New Program) , Biomedical Sciences(New Program) and Business Entrepreneurship.

State Approved CTE Program:

Electrical Trades, CAD (Computer Aided Design), Apparel and Textiles, Hotel, Restaurant and Tourism Management (New Program) .

Awaiting State Approval: Submitted in Substantially Approvable Form


Allied Health(New Program) , Dance, Graphic Arts, Criminal Justice (New Program) and Cosmetology (Cosmetology will be submitted shortly).

CARES Act



- August 2020 CARES Act funds-The District received \$14,232,248 of which \$1,807,671 was equitable share.
- The requirements of the grant funds explicitly state that the funds “must be used to address the health and safety measures necessary to support reopening of in-person instruction and to support students during periods of remote learning.
- The NJDOE is actively conducting a Consolidated federal monitoring of grants state wide
 - To-date, 57 LEAs across the state have been audited. 40 LEAs were compliant and 17 LEAs had audit findings
 - LEAs with findings are referred to OFAC for determination and corrective action.



"Honoring Excellence in Academic Achievement"

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIAS

- Be a resident of and/or enrolled in a high school in Camden County (Southern New Jersey)
- Is a high school Senior planning to enroll in a full-time accredited four-year college or university in Fall 2021
- Show proof of college/university admission to a four-year accredited college/university in the United States is a condition of eligibility. For the scholarship award and will be required before funds will be disbursed. Funds will be disbursed during the Fall 2021 term only
- Must be an African American or Latino male
- The applicant must have documented involvement in extracurricular and community service activities and demonstrate leadership ability
- Have earned a 2.50 cumulative grade point average or higher on a 4.0 scale (or its equivalent)
- Completed application must be submitted via email or US postal mail on or before May 1, 2021.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc. is an international fraternal organization founded at Howard University on January 9, 1914. Since its inception in Camden in 1978, Zeta Rho Sigma Chapter, the local chapter of this organization, provides service to Camden County, New Jersey. The scholarship is named after Dr. Orlando L. Chandler, a charter member of Zeta Rho Sigma Chapter, who is committed to academic excellence, brotherhood and community service. Zeta Rho Sigma Chapter will provide scholarships to deserving African American males graduating from a high school in Camden County, New Jersey. This graduating senior must demonstrate academic excellence, community service and leadership. This is a merit-based scholarship.

APPLICATION

Interested students must complete the scholarship application along with the following:

- A 500-word maximum typed essay (See essay topic on application)
- Two (2) letters of recommendation (One must be from a teacher, counselor or school official and one must be from a community organization or church official)
- Official transcript of grades
- Application and essay must be typed (essay must be double spaced)

The application and all required supporting documents (transcript, letters of recommendation, single photo of the applicant and essay) must be postmarked on or before May 1, 2021. Incomplete applications, an application postmarked after May 1, 2021, will not be considered.


