* Your furniture piece can not be more than 8 inches big.





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

General Fund Balance




SY18 fund balance = \$7m

- SY20 fund balance = deficit of \$8m
- Increased costs and decreased state aid

General Fund Revenues




- > State aid primary source in 2020
- Local taxes provided 2.4% budget revenue
- All other sources provided1.2% of revenues



Annual Audit

General Fund Expenditures



- 2020 Total General Fund expenditures = \$345,776,37
- \$149.9m transferred to Charter & Renaissance schools
- \$18.8m paid to private schools and other districts
- Tuition payments = 49% of total expenditures







