

CTE Path

The Standard track provides students with the opportunity to take career & technical education courses, advanced placement courses, dual enrollment courses.

Students leave high school with the opportunity to enroll in college or enter the workforce. The Pre-College track provides students the opportunity to prepare for the college classroom.

Students are able to take a combination of Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment courses.

CCSD is partnering with Stockton University, Bard College, Camden College College, Rowan University, and Rutgers university to provide dual enrollment/credit.

Early College track offers students the ability to earn their high school diploma and college credit simultaneously.

The program significantly lowers the cost of a college education for students and their parents.

CCSD is partnering with Rowan University to provide associate degrees to seniors of CCSD.

The Career & Technical Education track (CTE) provides students the opportunity to prepare for industry specific careers that do not require a 2/4 year degree.

Students will graduate from CCSD with industry credentials ready to enter the workforce.



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

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District Highlights



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- The District continues to look for opportunities to offload vacant buildings.
- Vacant buildings are costly for the District to maintain and have the potential to create blight in the community.
- Revenue generated from the sale of vacant buildings will be invested in our schools.



- Last summer, the District put out an RFB advertising vacant facilities for sale.
- Included in this RFB was Hatch, which is slated to be vacant when the new Camden High School opens this fall.
- After engaging in the RFB process and securing DOE approval, the
 District is moving forward with selling Hatch to KIPP for \$1,600,000.
- KIPP will renovate the building and use it as a middle school.

 The \$1.6 million generated from the Hatch sale will be immediately invested in important capital projects at Camden High & Woodrow Wilson, including the Bleachers, Track, and Ticket Booth.











- The District will continue to look for opportunities to offload vacant buildings.
- We are currently engaged in negotiations with grassroots, community-based organizations for other advertised facilities.
- If agreements are reached and DOE approval is secured, we will move forward with additional sales and notify the public.
- All revenue from sales will be invested back into schools we operate.




