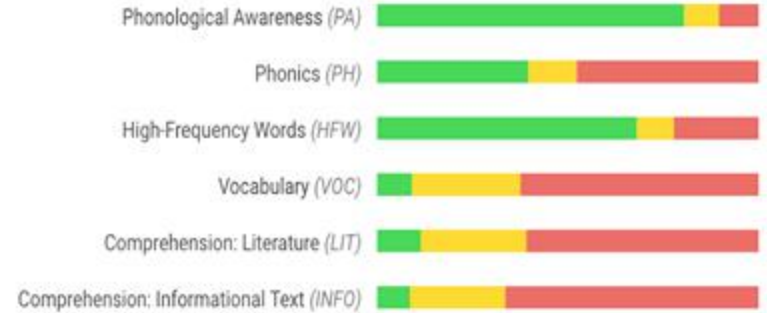

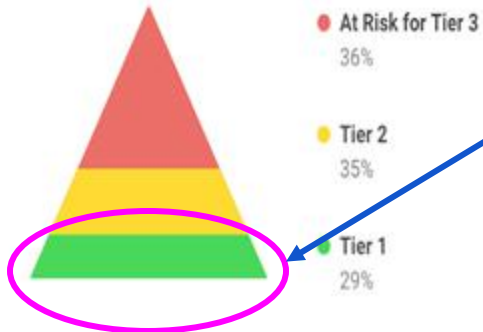

FALL 2018 Data

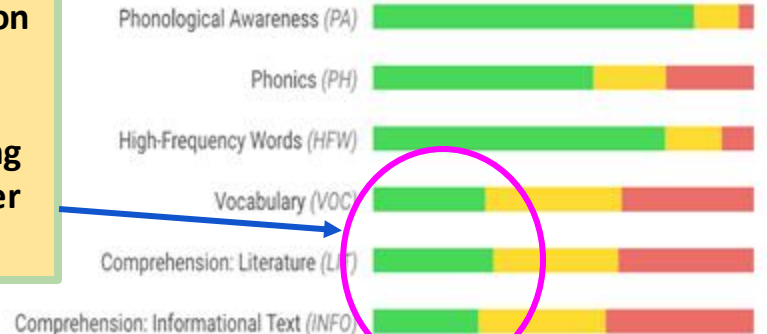


SPRING 2019 Data



22% increase- more students reading on grade level

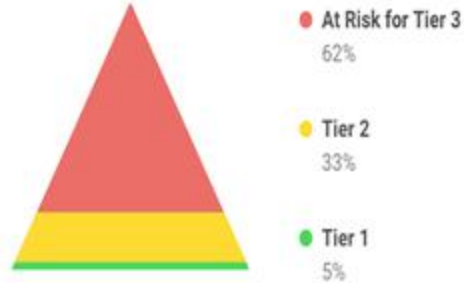
More kids showing progress on harder skills!



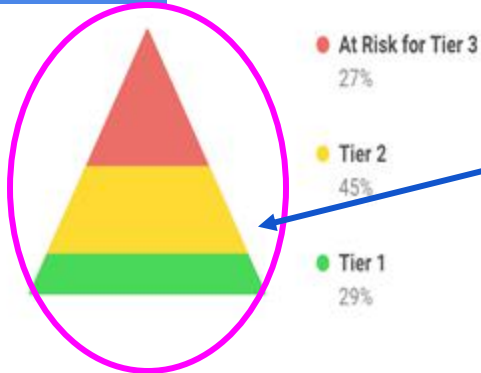

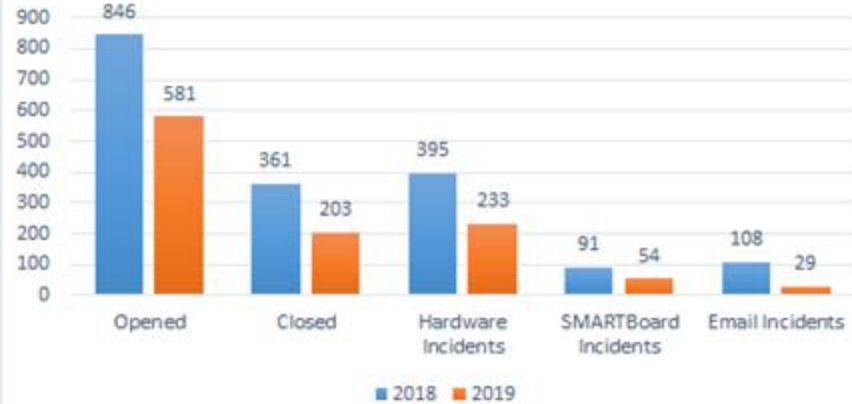

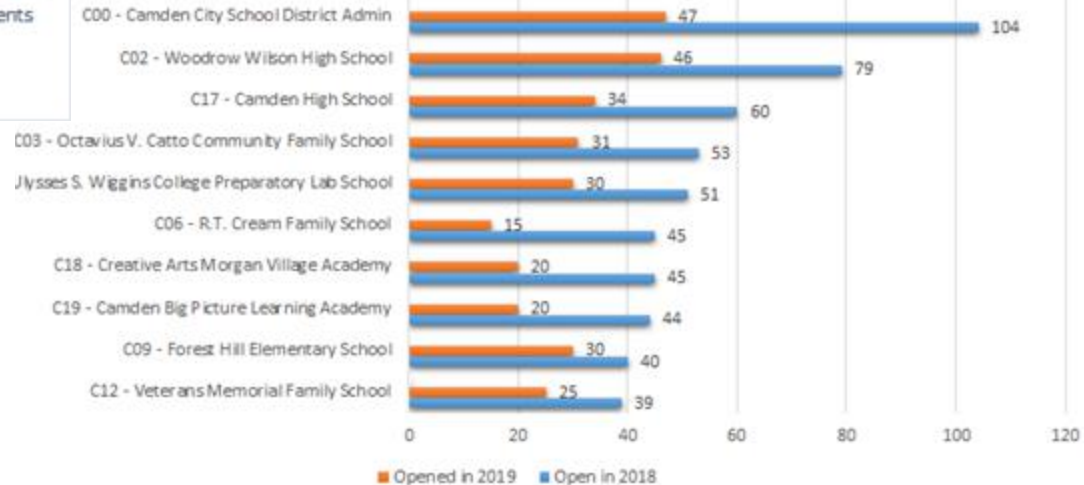
