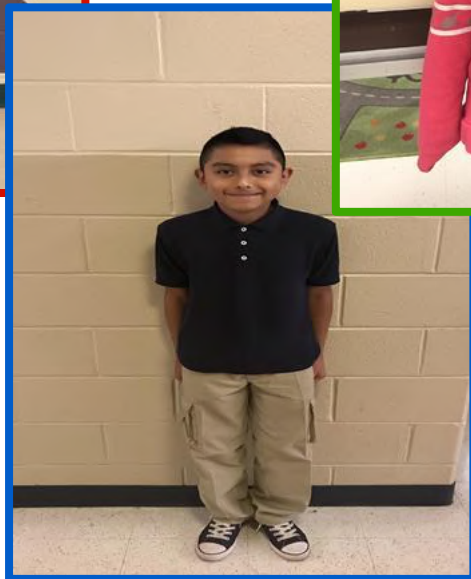



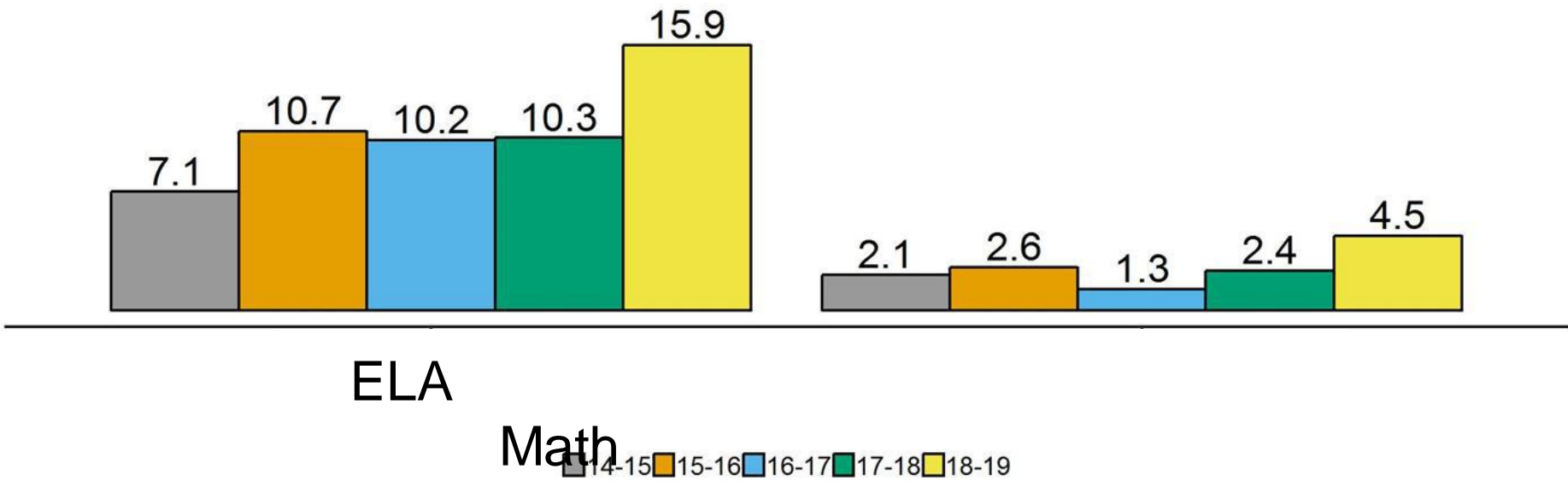

District Results: HS Proficiency %

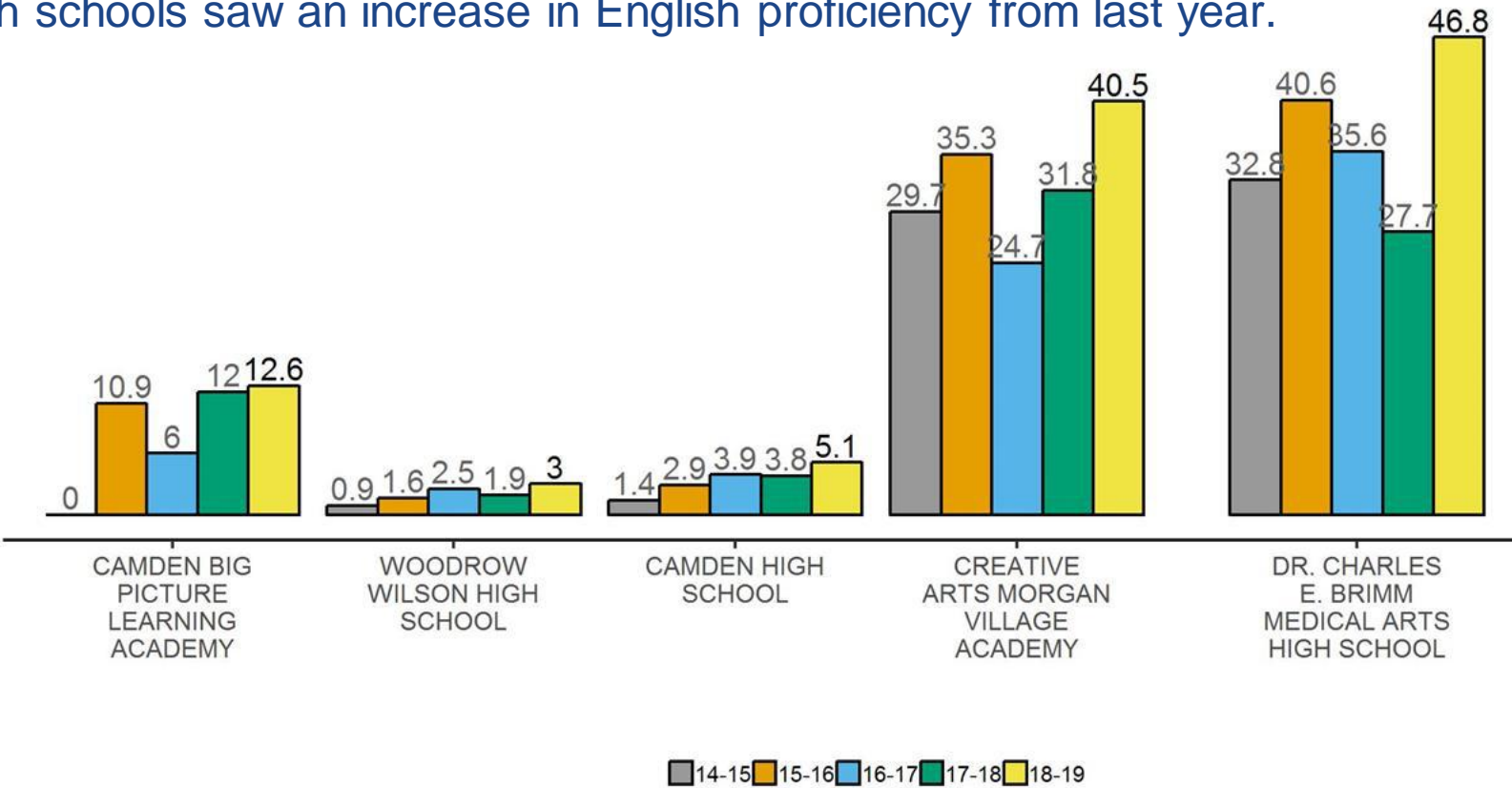
Twice as many high school students are proficient in math, and significantly more high schoolers are proficient in English than ever before.

District Proficiency Rates (High School)



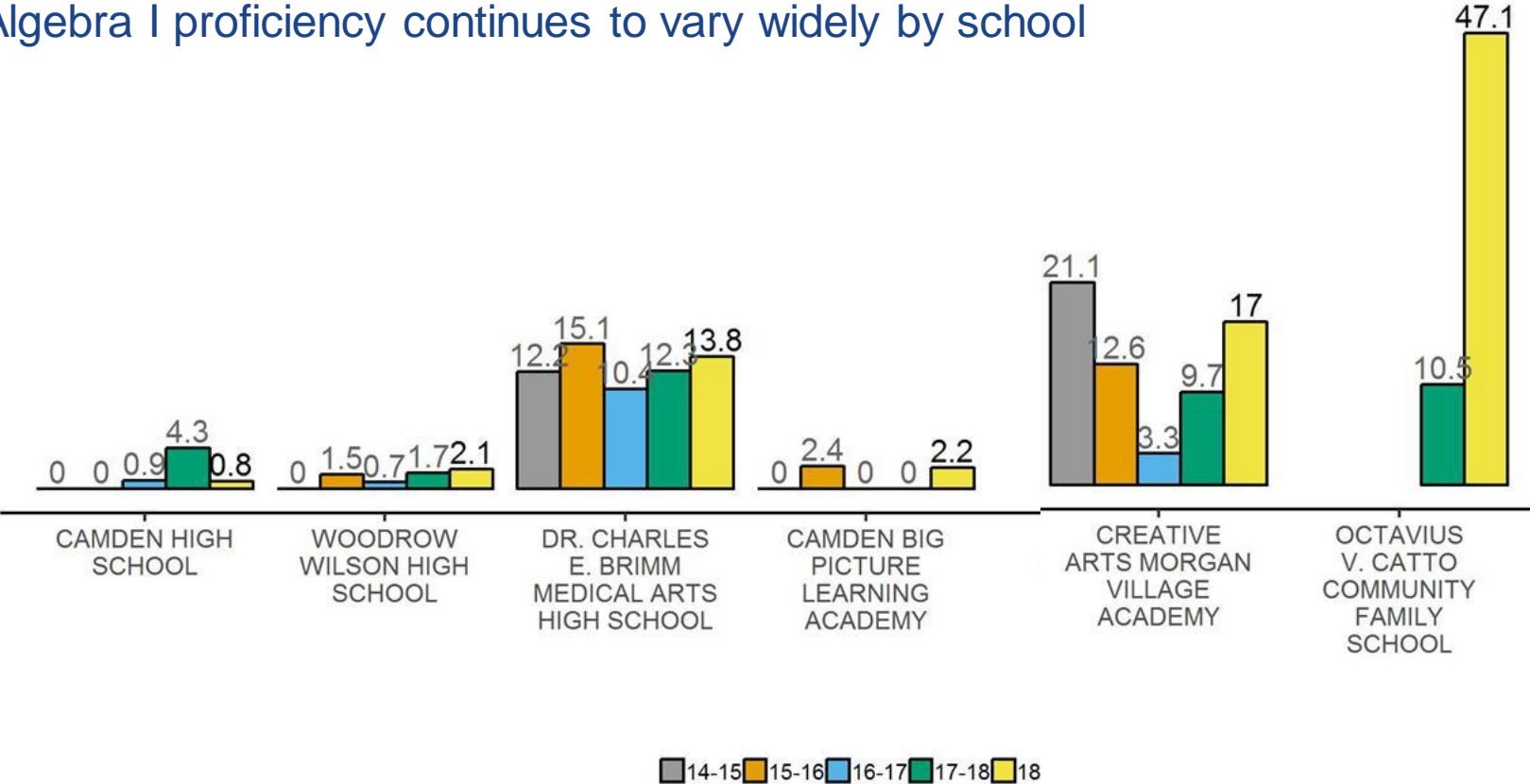
District Results: HS ELA Proficiency %

All high schools saw an increase in English proficiency from last year.



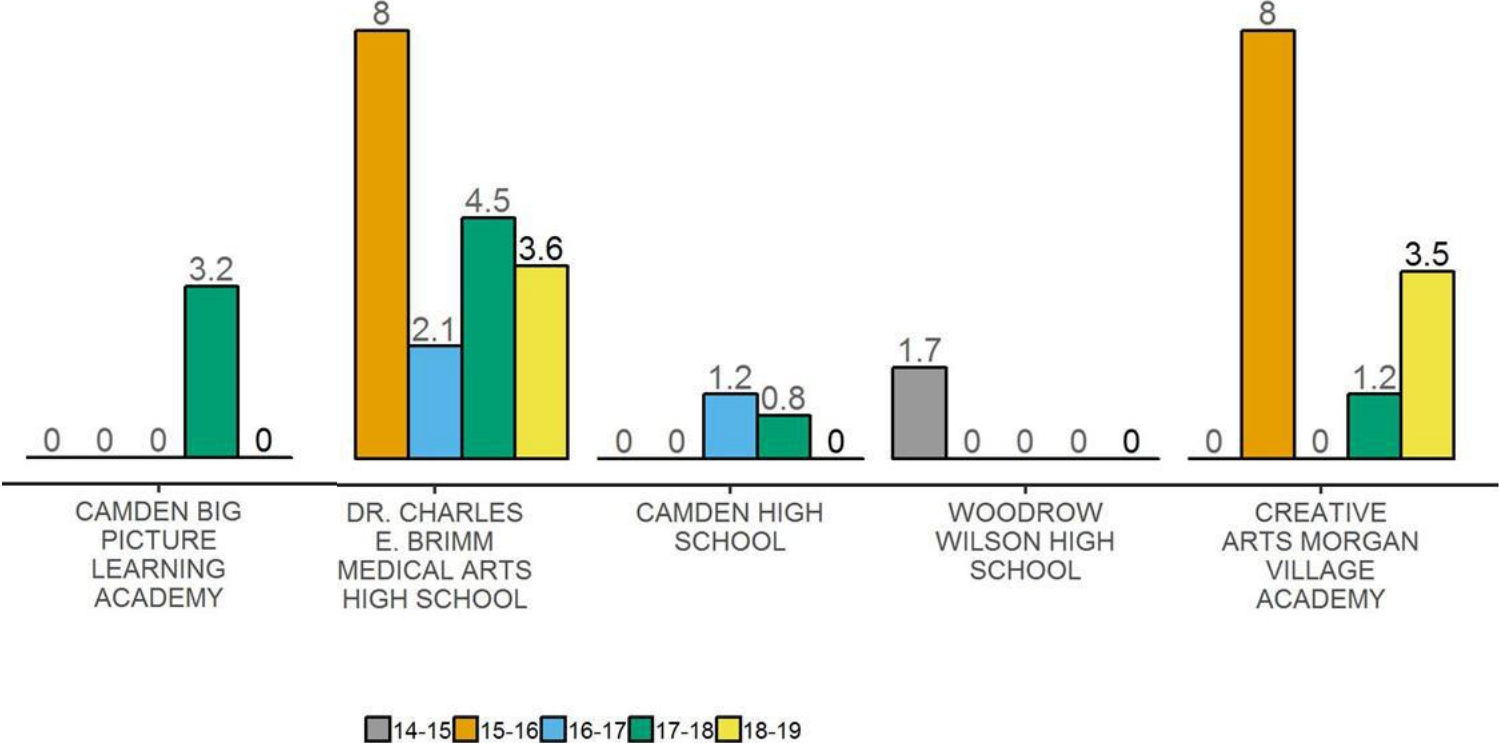
District Results: Algebra Proficiency %

Algebra I proficiency continues to vary widely by school



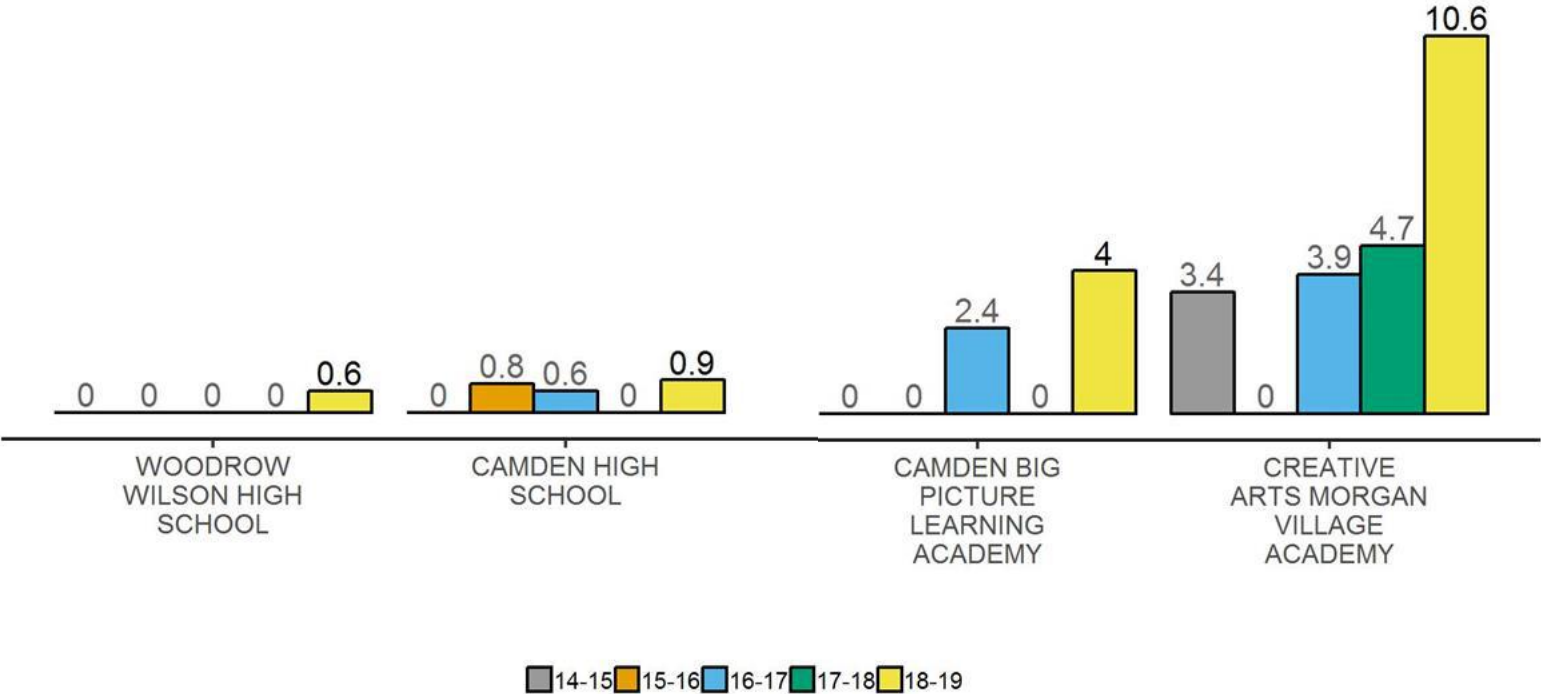
District Results: Algebra II Proficiency %

Algebra II continues to be the subject where students show low levels of proficiency



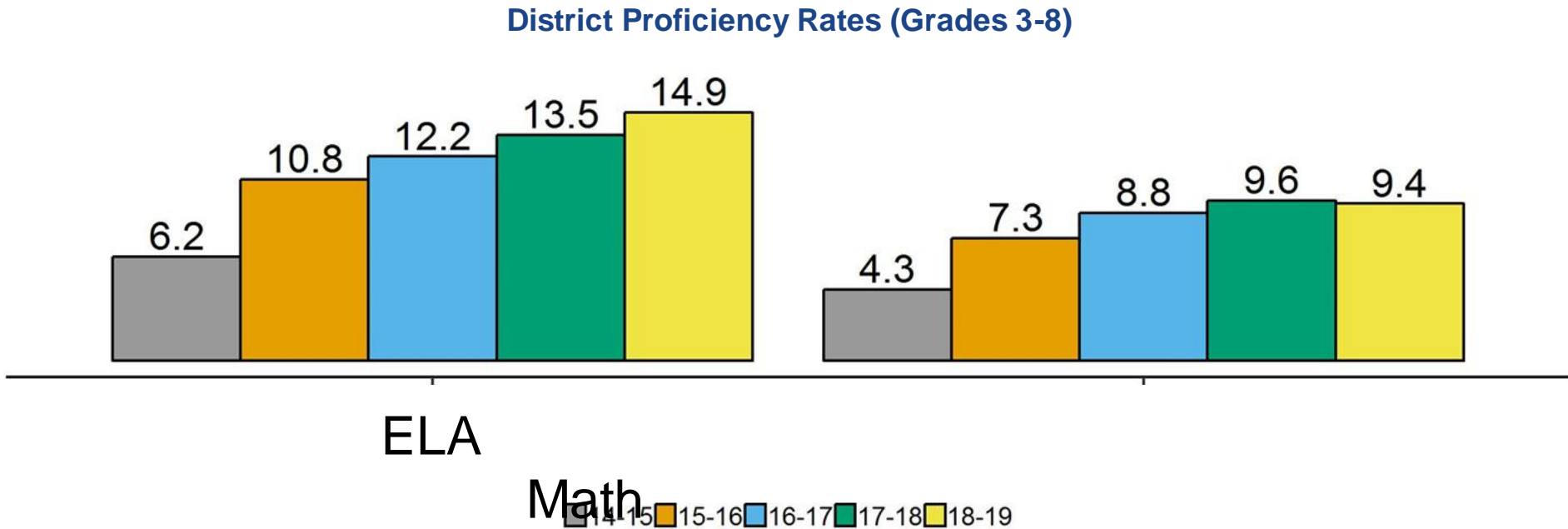
District Results: Geometry Proficiency %

All high schools saw an increase in proficiency in Geometry



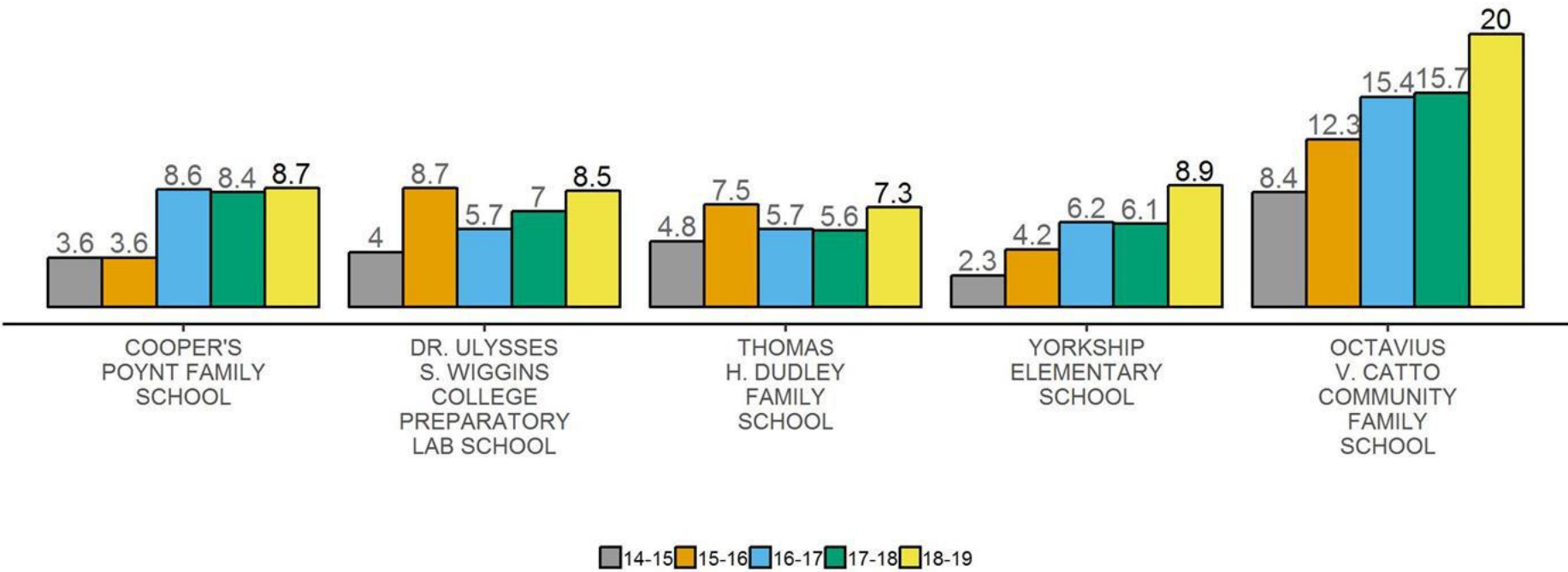
District Results: Grades 3-8 Proficiency %

For grades 3-8, incrementally more district students are proficient in literacy, with relatively steady performance in math.



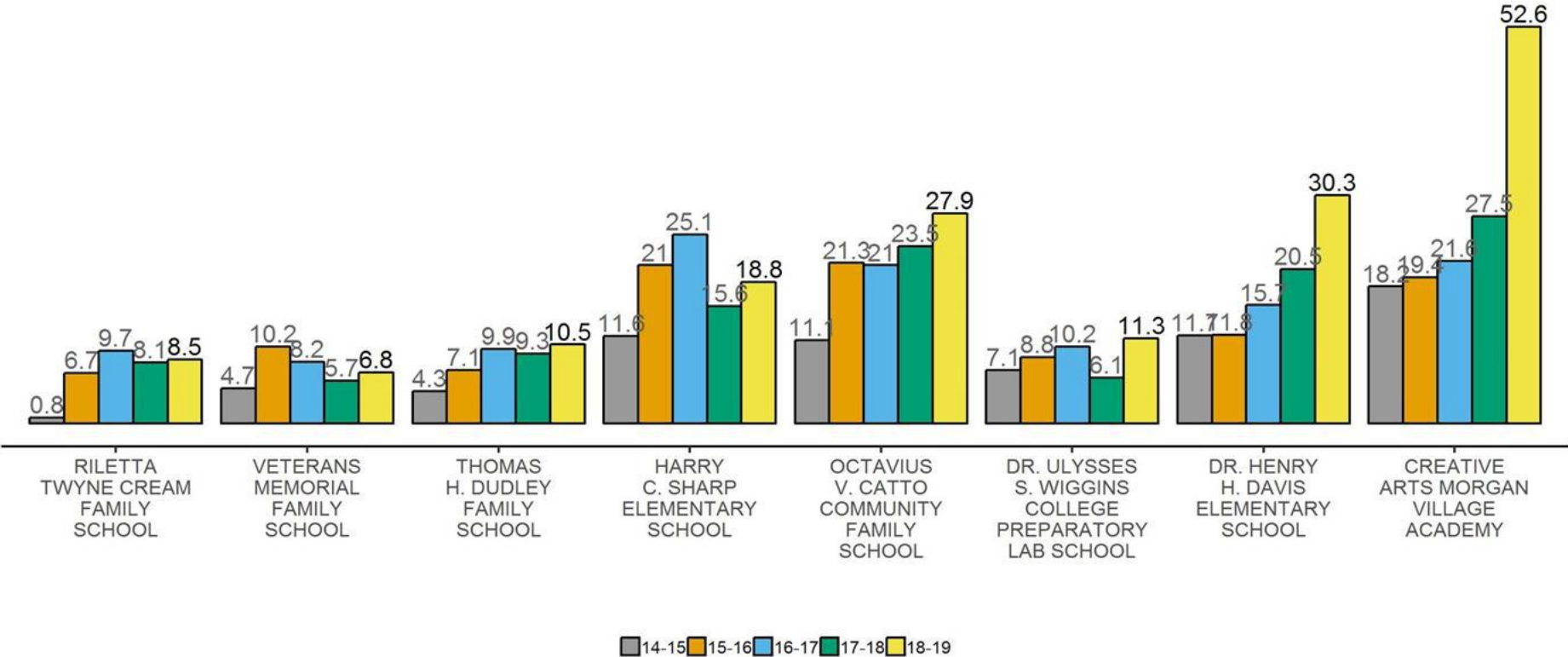
District Results: Grades 3-8 Math Proficiency %

5 family schools saw an increase in proficiency since last year in math (grades 3-8)

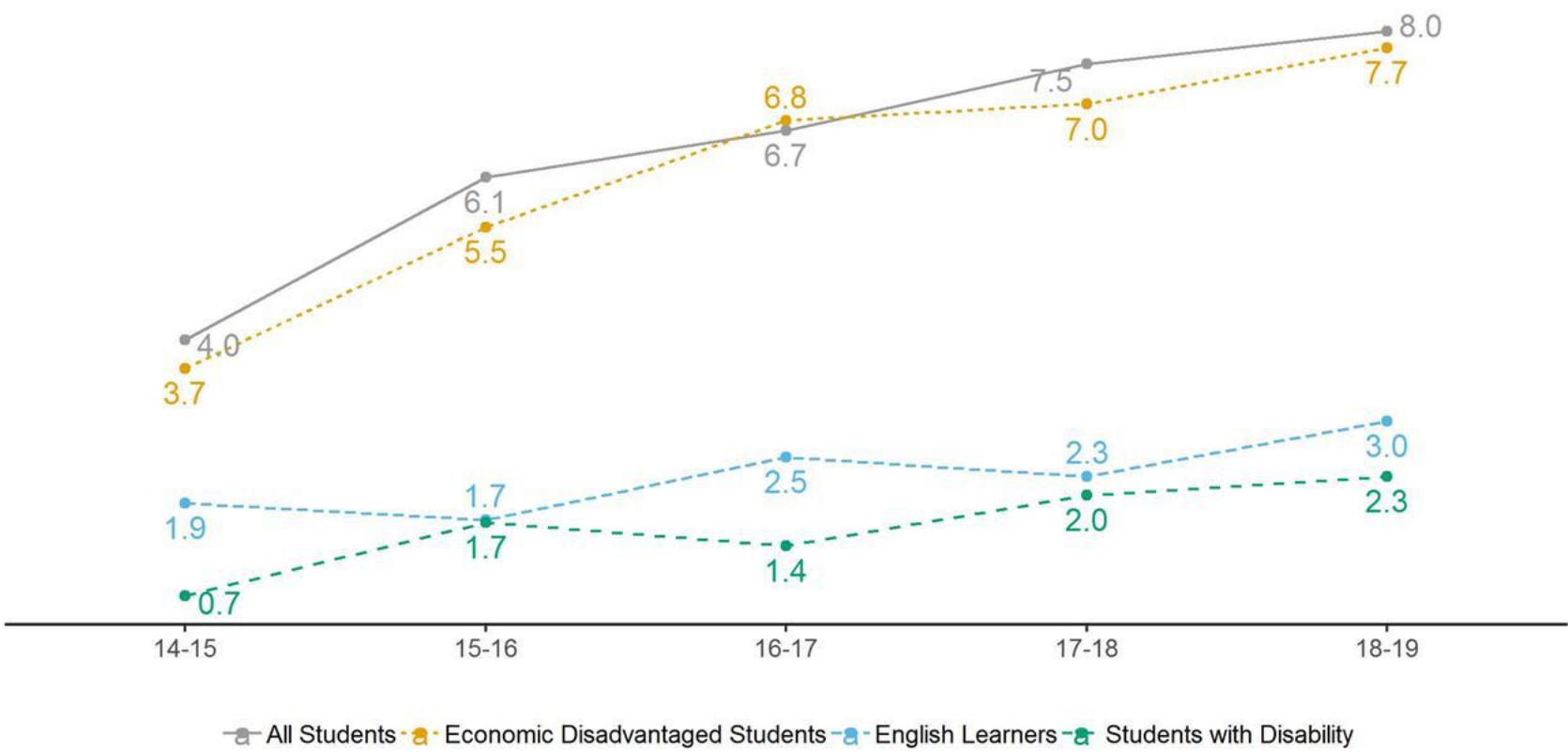


District Results: Grades 3-8 English Language Arts (ELA) Proficiency %

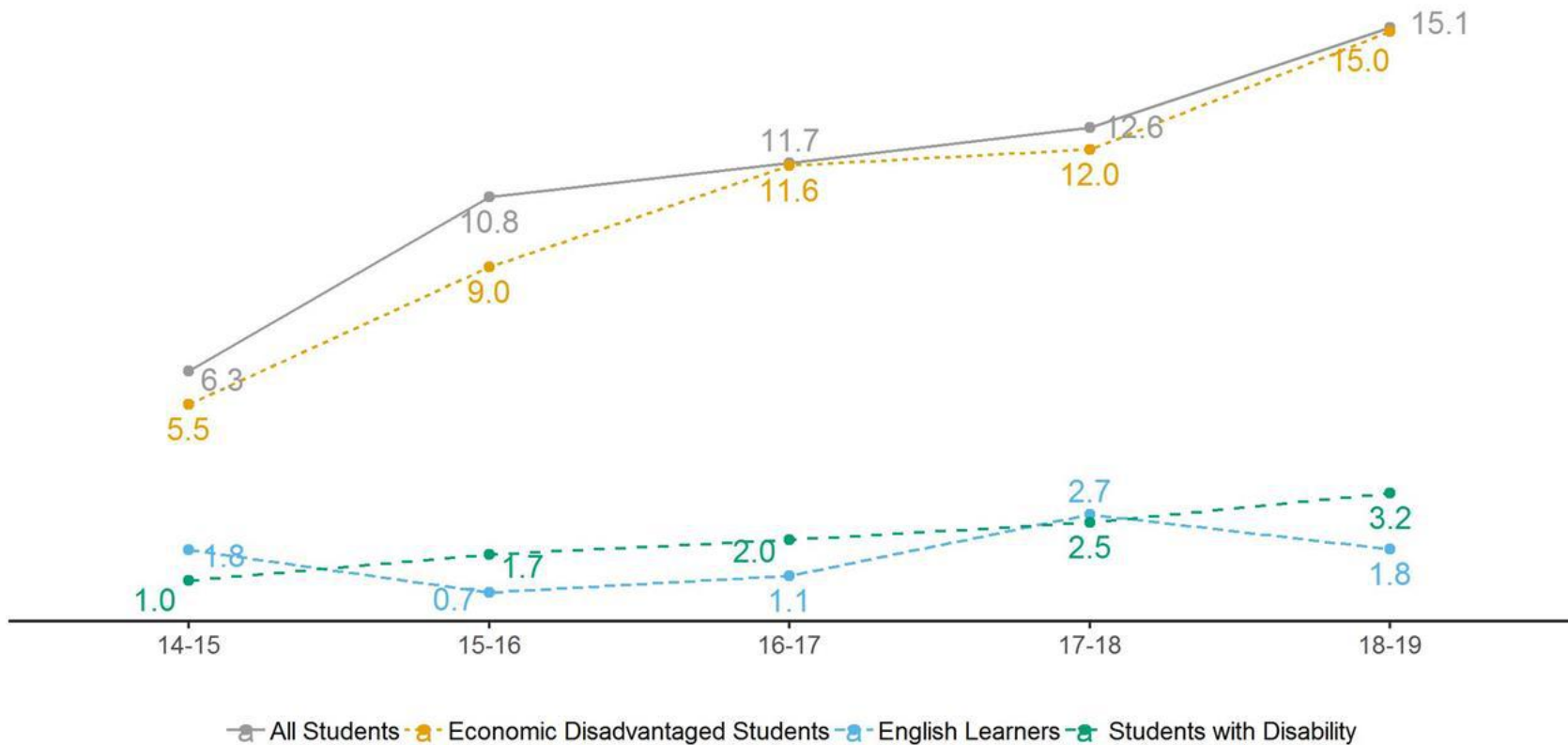
8 district schools saw an increase in proficiency from last year in literacy (grades 3-8)

District Results: Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) Performance

For the 75 students that took DLM, more than 34% are on target or higher in ELA and almost 32% are on target or higher in math.

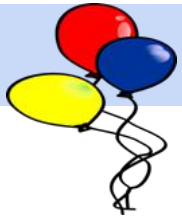
