V. HEALTH SERVICES (Kenny)

Our residents can also help the school nurse with vision and hearing screenings; they can review immunization records, they can help track growth and BMI changes.
- 5. Our residents have been a part of "ask the doctor" after school sessions for interested parents.
- 6. Some of the residents are foreign born and could speak to students about life growing up in another country. They can speak to the student's in middle and the high schools about test taking, studying and what it takes to get into medical school or college in general.
