The Camden School District will provide 50 high school students with a 5-week paid summer job

The program will run for 5-weeks between July 14 and August 13. Students between the ages of 14-18 will work 5 hours per day, 4 days per week, and earn \$11 per hour.

While there are many different pathways to high-wage and high-skilled jobs, the district's goal is to ensure students are prepared. The students will be attending their first orientation July 14th from 9am - 3pm. During the orientation, students will be matched up with entry-level positions within the school district and/or local organizations.
