



Start Strong Assessment Results: Background



<u>Administered Across Content Areas</u> - English language arts (ELA) grades 4–10; Mathematics grades 4–8, Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II; and Science (6, 9 & 12).



<u>Standards Aligned</u> - Assessment aligned to the previous year's academic standards to help educators understand the level of support students require for current grade-level instruction.




<u>Brief</u> - The test can be administered in a single class period (45–60 minutes). Administration set up and security procedures are similar to traditional state assessments, with some exceptions.







ARP ESSER TIMELINE

ARP ESSER Application due to NJDOE by November 24, 2021 NJDOE review period for ARP ESSER Applications statewide Districts are permitted to begin drawing down ARP ESSER funds for expenditures

All ARP ESSER funds must be encumbered.

November 2021

December to February 2022

March 2022

June 2023






