

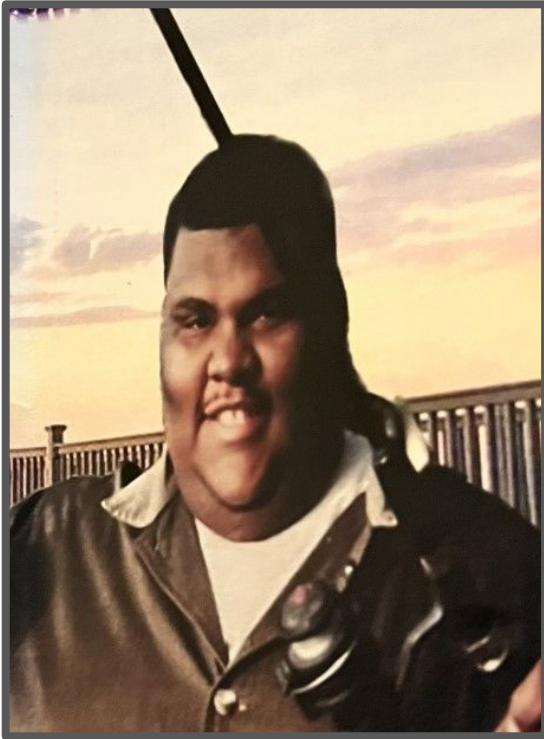

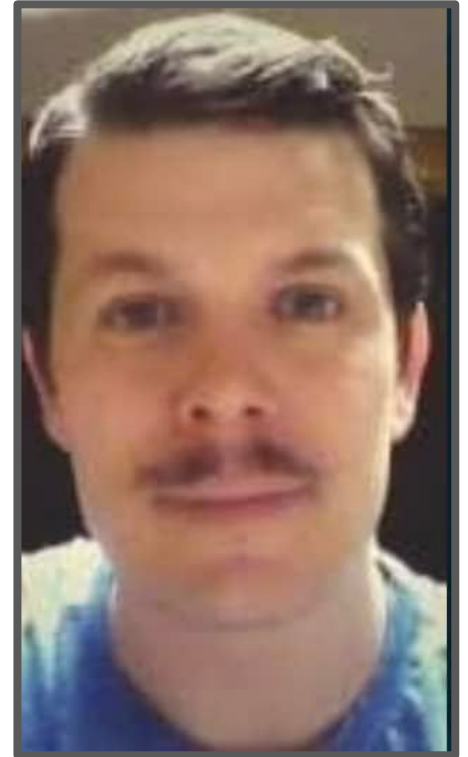

Start Strong Assessment Results: Background



Administered Across Content Areas - English language arts (ELA) grades 4–10; Mathematics grades 4–8, Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II; and Science (6, 9 & 12).



Standards Aligned - Assessment aligned to the previous year's academic standards to help educators understand the level of support students require for current grade-level instruction.



Brief - The test can be administered in a single class period (45–60 minutes). Administration set up and security procedures are similar to traditional state assessments, with some exceptions.
