Covanta Camden

- The Camden facility is proposing to upgrade our Air Pollution Control (APC) System with a \$49 million dollar investment.
 - Installation of a state-of-the-art fabric filter baghouses
 - Higher efficiency of acid gas removal with a dry recirculating ash system.
 - Enhanced existing SNCR system for NOx control
- A new APC system will significantly reduce most emissions including particulates, lead, mercury, dioxin, and acid gases.
- Covanta will propose lower emission limits.
- No increase in permitted throughput, however the facility will Receive and process liquid wastes
- Develop a Community Benefits Agreement (CBA) with the local community.




