## Camden City School District Announces \$49M "Investment in Equity" at Eastside High School

**Camden, NJ** – On Friday, November 4, 2022, Superintendent McCombs will be joined by Congressman Norcross, NJ State Senator Cruz-Perez, Mayor Carstarphen, Council President Fuentes, and other dignitaries as she announces the district's \$49 million "Investment in Equity" at Eastside High School. The announcement will provide a scope of the work to be conducted along with a timeline from bid to fruition followed by the unveiling of Eastside High School Tiger statue.

"We're doing more than investing in Eastside High School, we're providing equity throughout our district and ensuring that our students are presented with the same educational opportunity throughout our city," said Camden City School District Superintendent, Katrina T. McCombs. "This investment will help us provide each employee and student with the modernized school building they deserve."

"All we want as parents is for our kids to have a fair shot at life, to have opportunities to succeed, said Congressman Donald Norcross. "I'm proud to have secured funding that gives our kids a safe, modern environment in which to learn, and I'll keep working in Congress to open doors for our teachers and students so they can excel."

The renovations are being supported through Elementary & Secondary School Relief (ESSER) funds allotted as part of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

Eastside High School is one of two public high schools run by the district. The building was opened in 1930 as a 29,300 square-foot school that serves students in grades 9 through 12.

"Eastside High has been a landmark in East Camden since 1930 and has played a critical role in our community for almost a century," NJ State Senator Cruz-Perez said. "This asset is getting a once in a generation renovation that will create equity for students in the city and renew a sense of pride for this institution on Federal Street. I want to commend our superintendent and our congressman for their undying commitment to the residents of the city and their tireless effort to deliver the funding that will get this job done."

The \$49 million dollar investment plan will renovate the following spaces within Eastside High School:

- Science Labs
- Art Rooms
- Automotive Room
- Cosmetology Room-
- Library
- Gymnasium
- Locker Rooms
- Front and Cafeteria Entrance
- Auditorium
- HVAC
- Lighting

Following the announcement, the media is invited to tour three of the classrooms that will be renovated.
