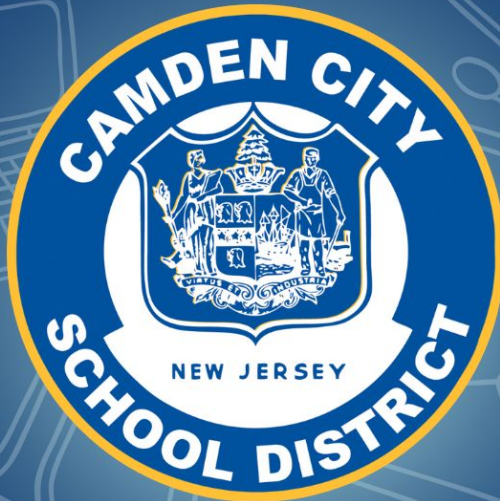

NJGPA Field Test Legislation



- July 5, 2022, Governor Murphy signed P.L.2022, c.60 (ACS for A-3196/S-2349), which requires the State Board of Education to administer the NJGPA as a **field test** for class of 2023.
- The law also **prohibits the results** of the NJGPA field test (First Pathway), a substitute competency test (Second Pathway), or portfolio appeal (Third Pathway) from being used as prerequisite for graduation for students expected to graduate in the class of 2023.
- There is **no graduation assessment requirement for any student** who is expected to graduate with the **class of 2023**.





NJGPA Overview



- NJGPA is designed to measure the extent to which students are graduation ready in English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics.
- Graduation readiness is reported separately for each content component.
- The ELA component is aligned to the grade 10 standards.
- The Mathematics component is aligned to Algebra I and Geometry standards.

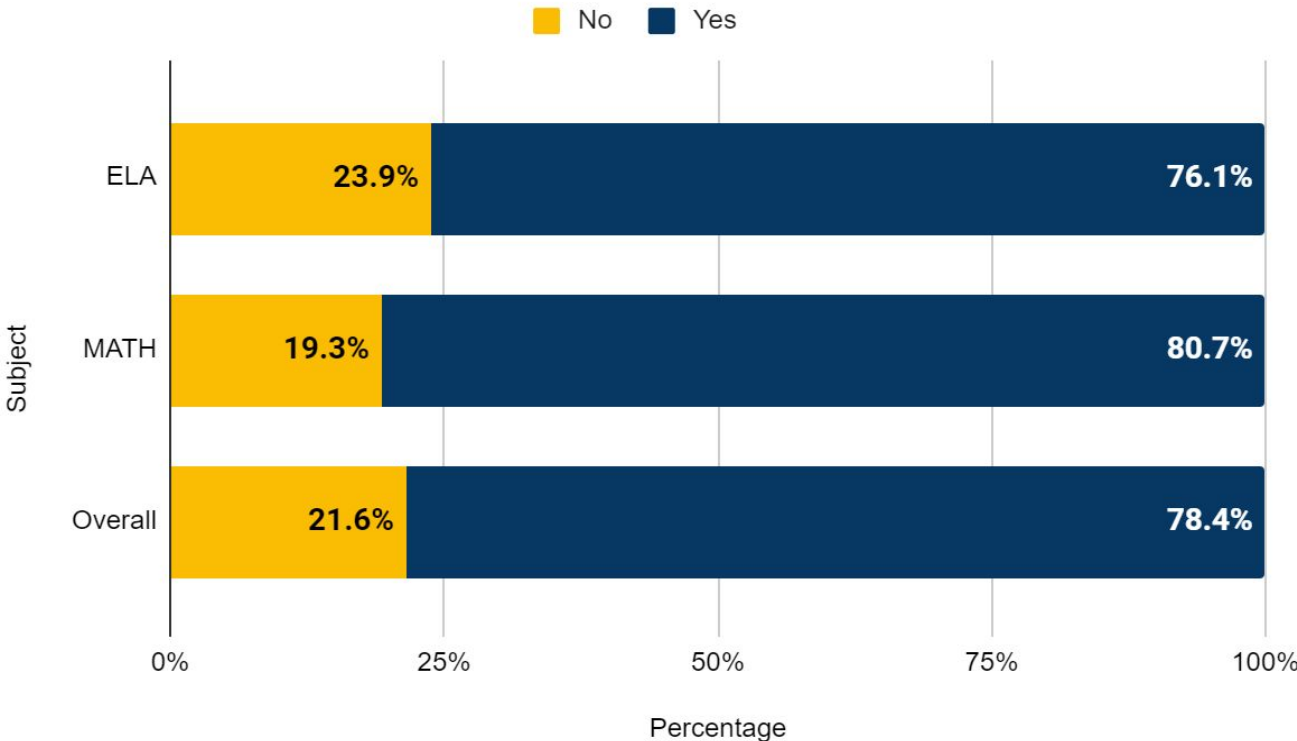

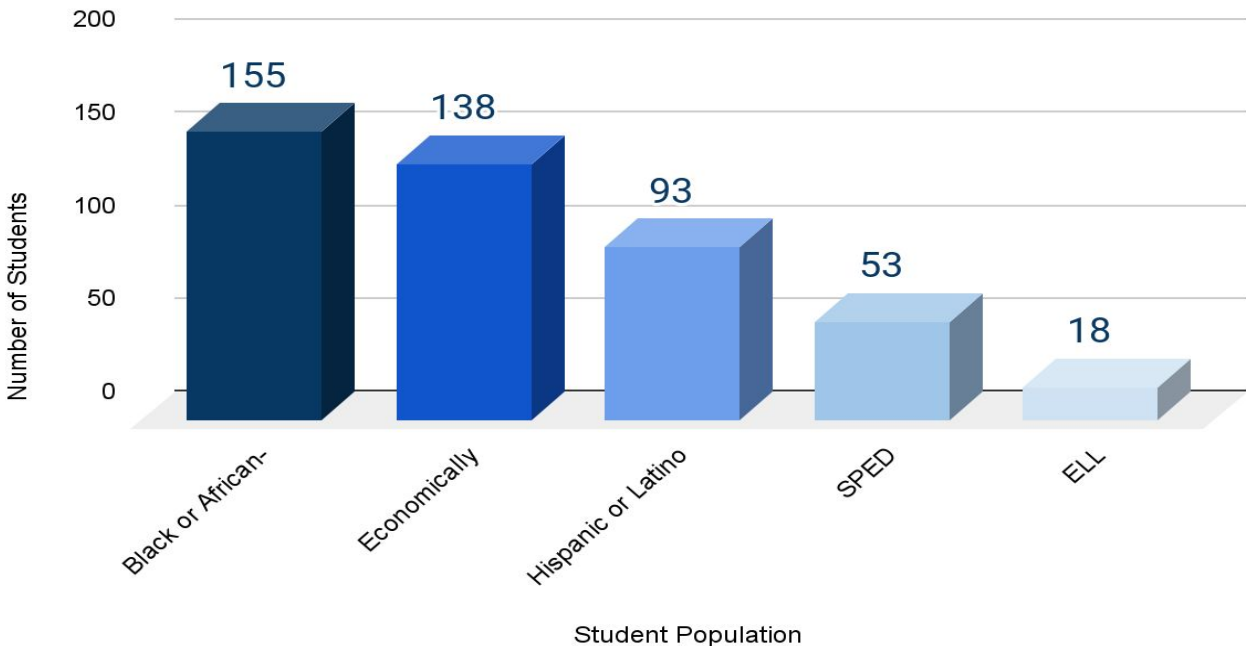

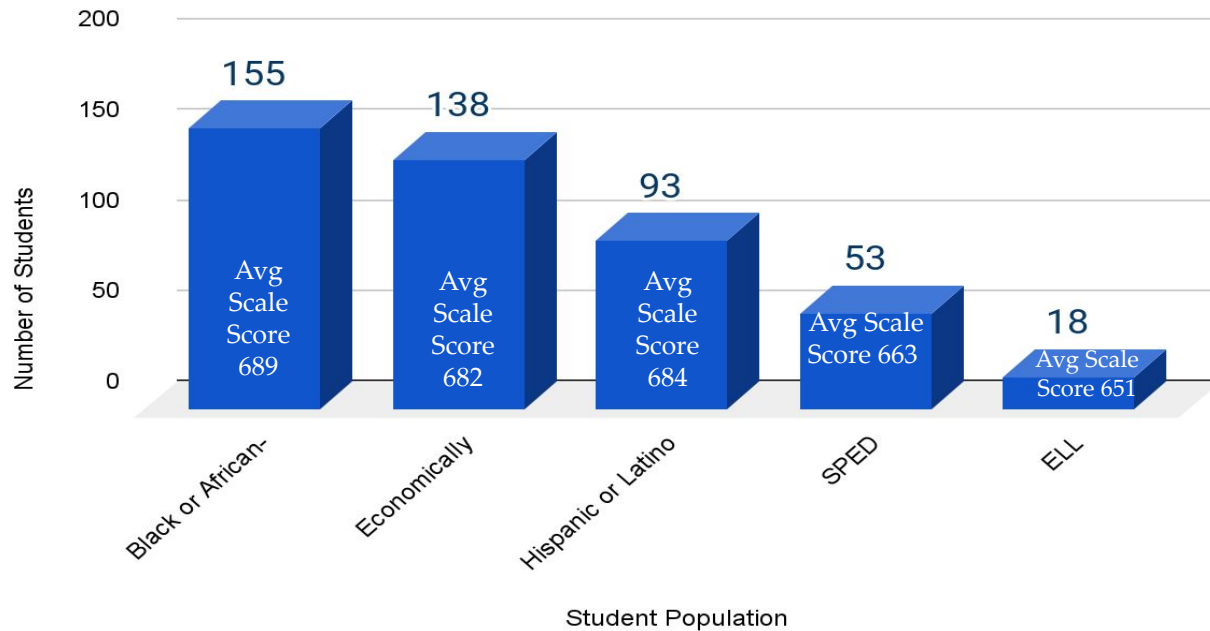
ELA Subgroup Chart - Not Graduation Ready

ELA Subgroup Chart - Not Graduation Ready

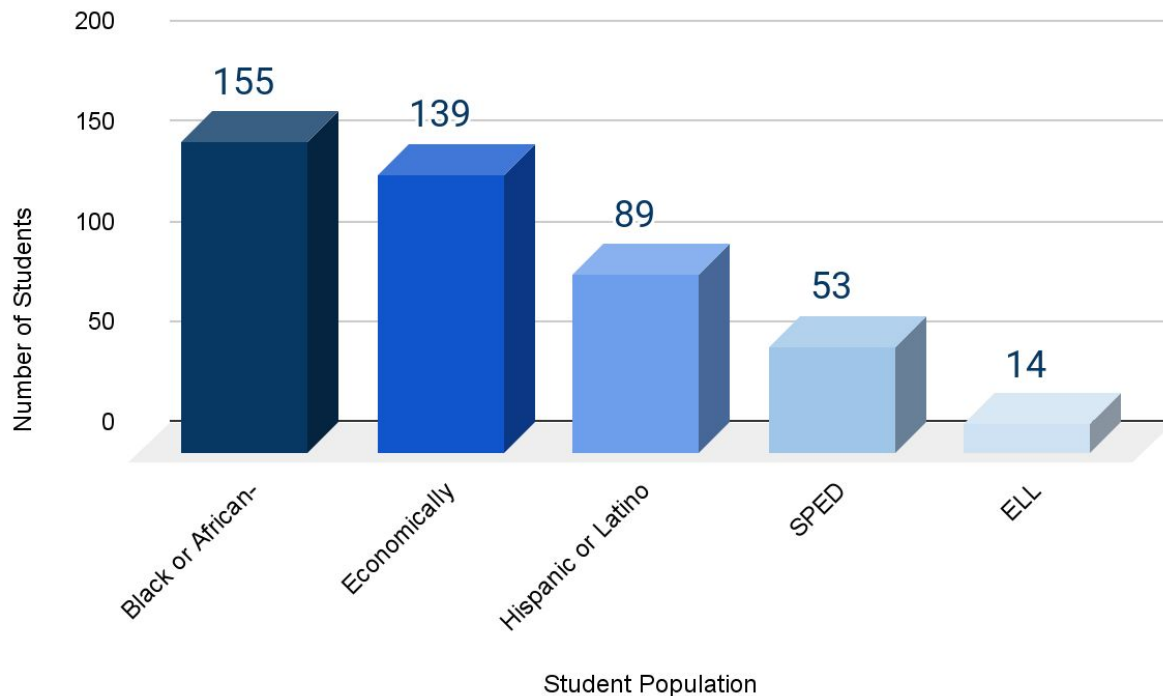

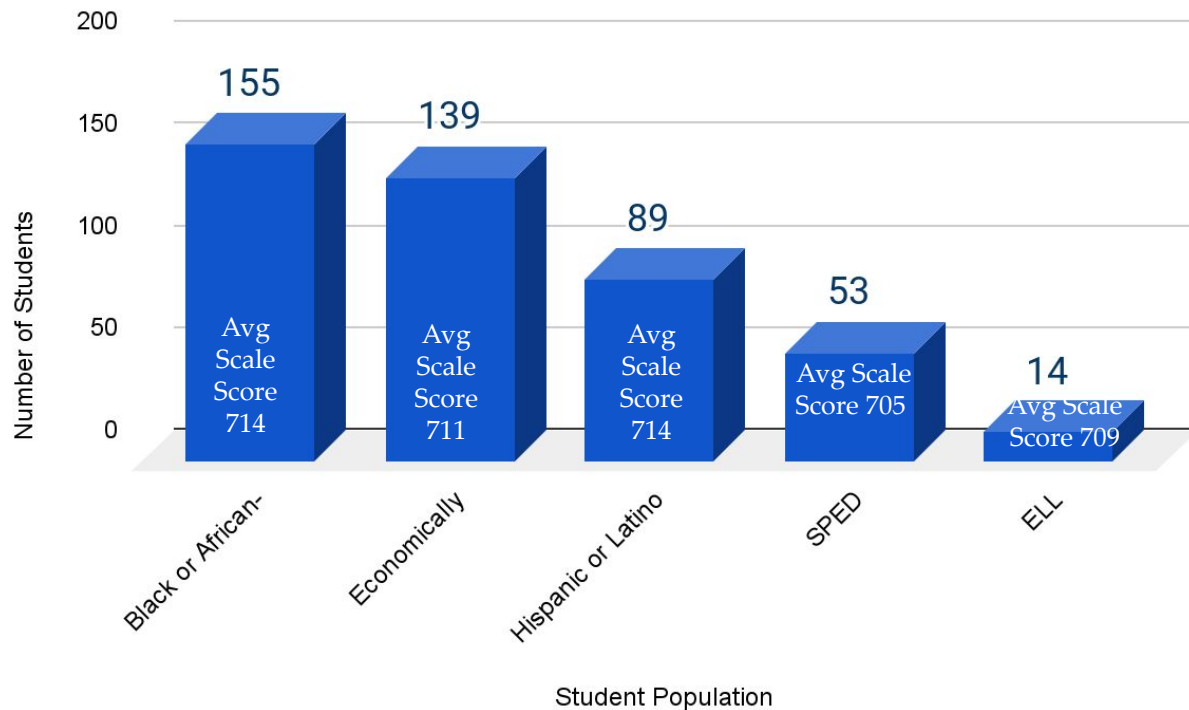


MATH Subgroup Chart - Not Graduation Ready

NJGPA Field Test Result Considerations



- NJGPA field test results from spring 2022 may be used to:
 - Review curriculum and programming.
 - Identify potential focus areas in preparation for the spring 2023 administration of NJGPA to students expected to graduate in the class of 2024.



Intervention Strategies for All



Utilize NJGPA Evidence Statements for pacing, curriculum developments and district unit assessments.



Monthly Professional Development for teachers centered on differentiation through Inspired Instruction, SLEC, and ELA/SS Liaisons



Additional Bi-monthly, job-embedded professional development via our math vendor.



Expanded enrollment in the afterschool program with a focus on ELA, Math and Science testing strategies utilizing NJGPA data.



ELA Intervention Strategies



- Zinc has been implemented in ELA classes to assess and track students' reading levels and growth. The program prescribes reading activities based on each student's individual level.
- Quill has been implemented in ELA classes to assess and support students' writing needs. Quill provides prescribed or assigned lessons for basic writing skills through Advanced Placement writing skills.
- Newsela is an additional resource used in ELA, Social Studies, and Science classes that provide texts at various levels for students and adjusts to each students “just right” level based on their performance on four standards based assessments



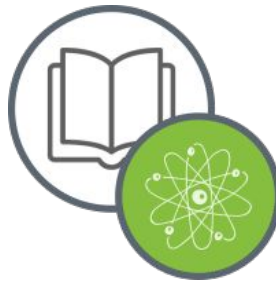

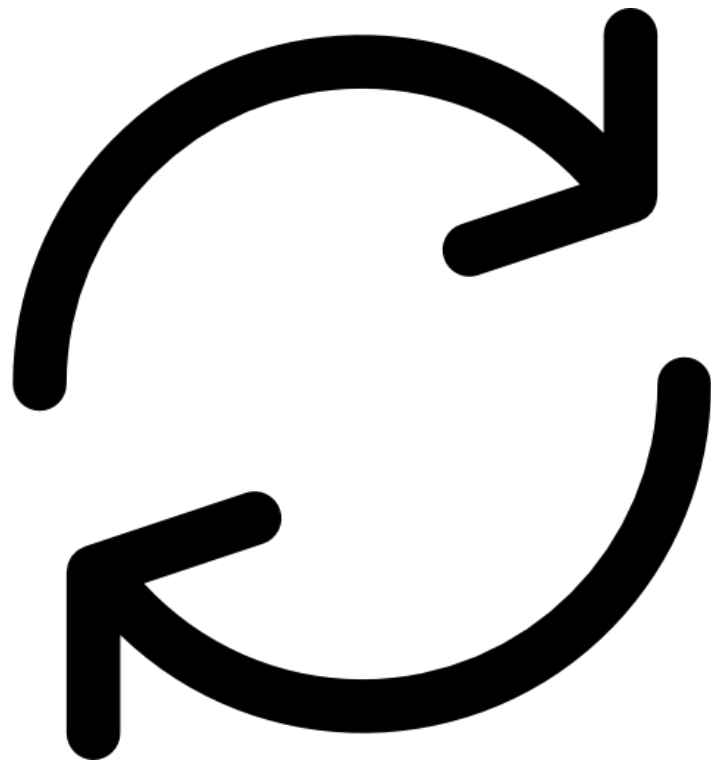


Math & Science Intervention Strategies



- Imagine Math, a computer adaptive program, is being used as support for the mathematics classrooms.
- Science received additional hands on materials for authentic labs.
- Weekly and bi-weekly common assessments aligned to standards and district pacing guides.
