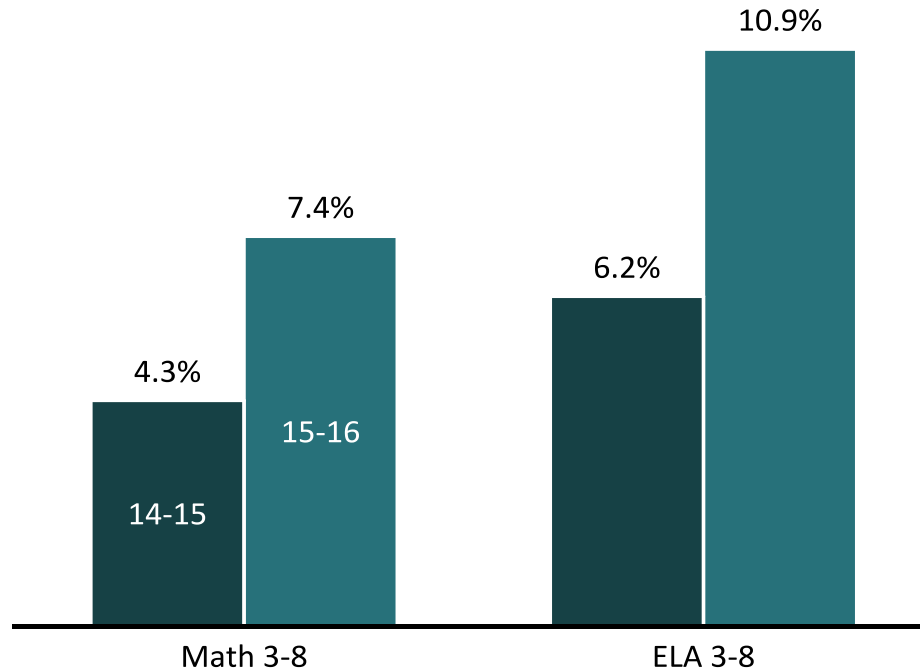

District Only, Grades 3-8

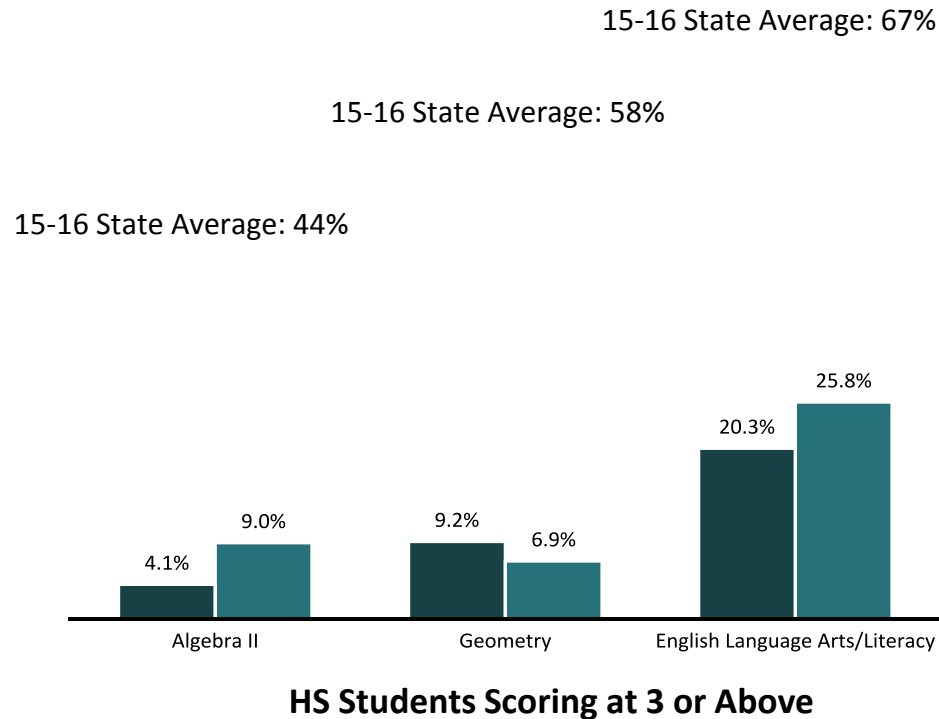


Overall, the District had **over 120 more** proficient students in math and **nearly 250 more** in English language arts.

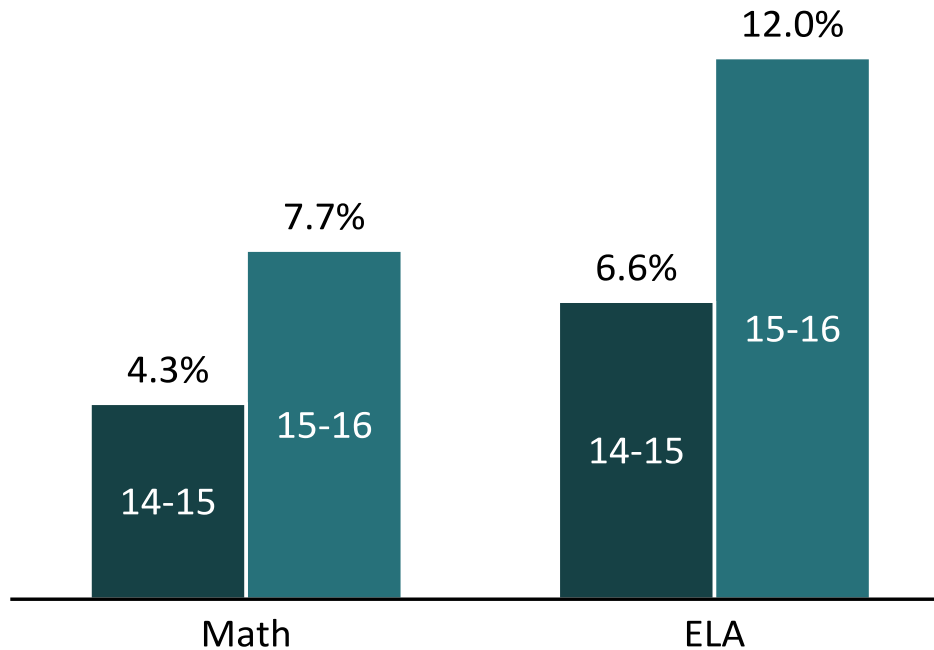

District and Renaissance Together, Grades 3-8



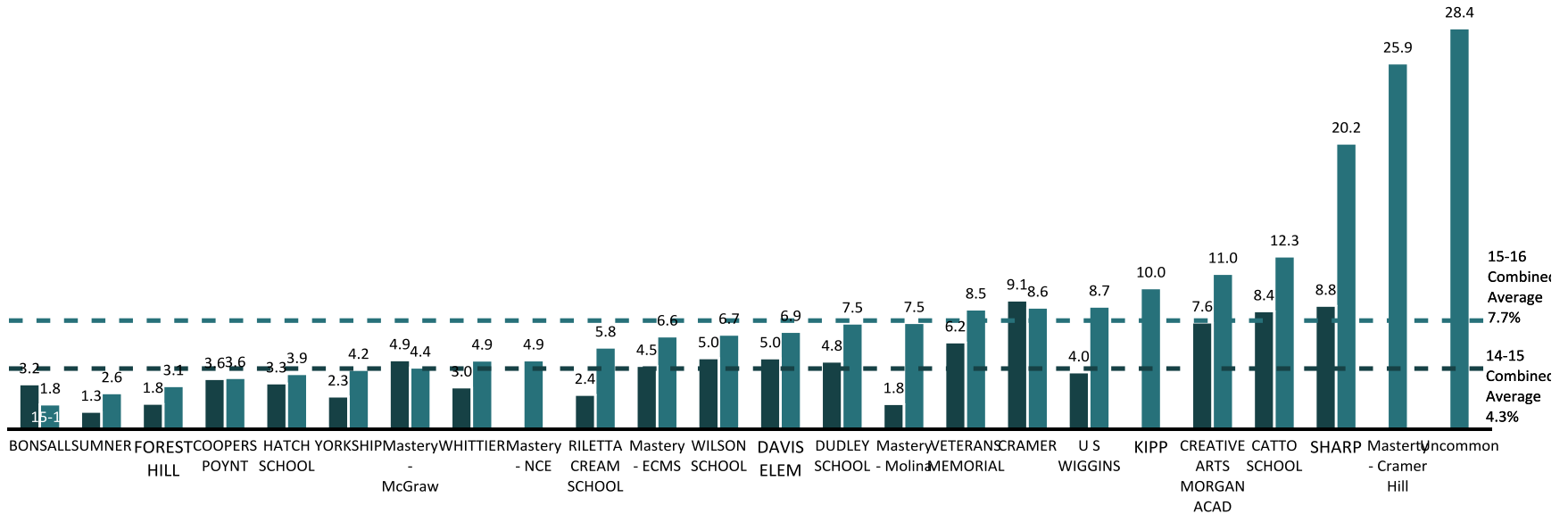
2015-16 PARCC RESULTS SUMMARY

Math Grades 3-8



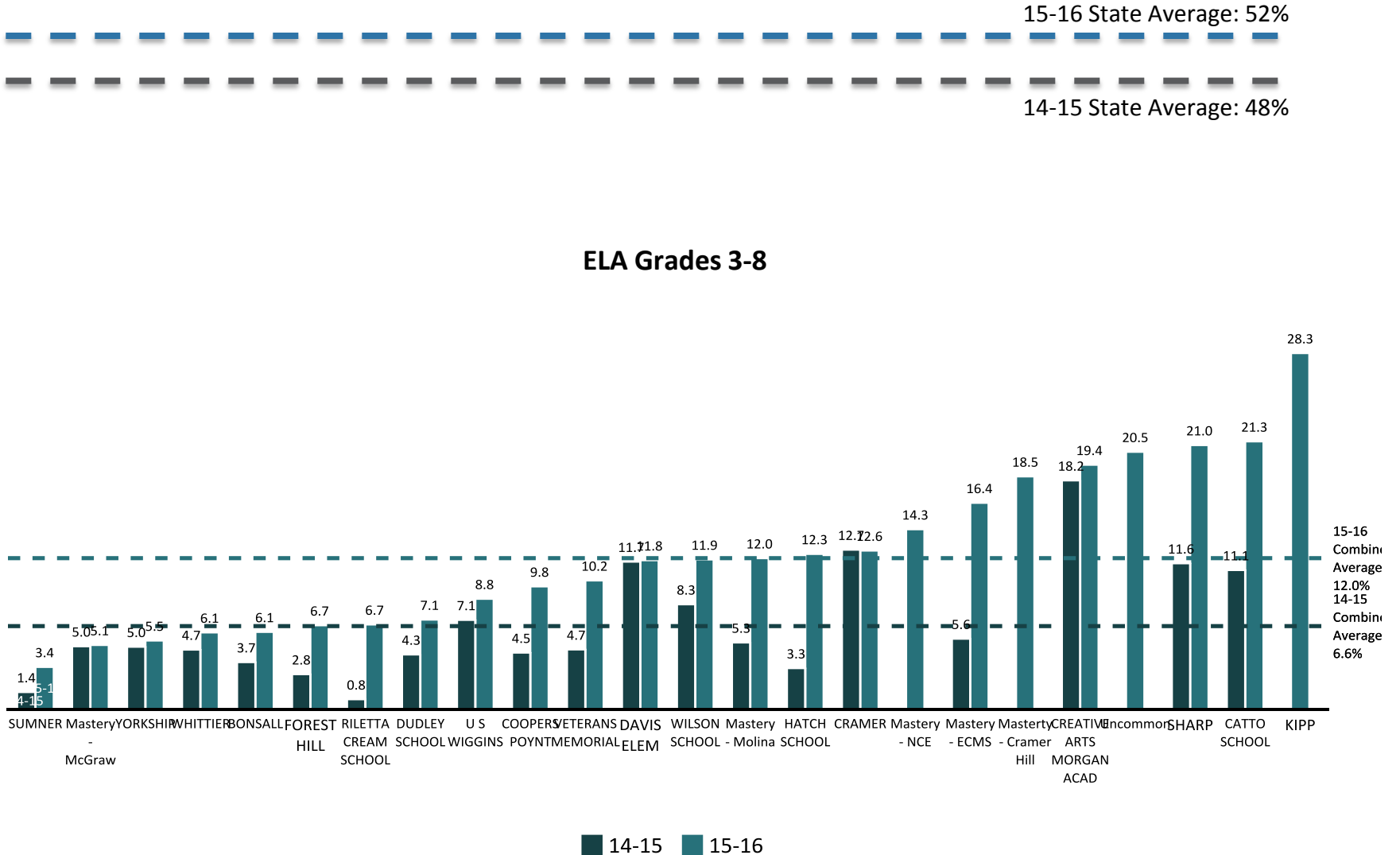

There was widespread improvement in ELA, too, and we also have a long way still to go here.



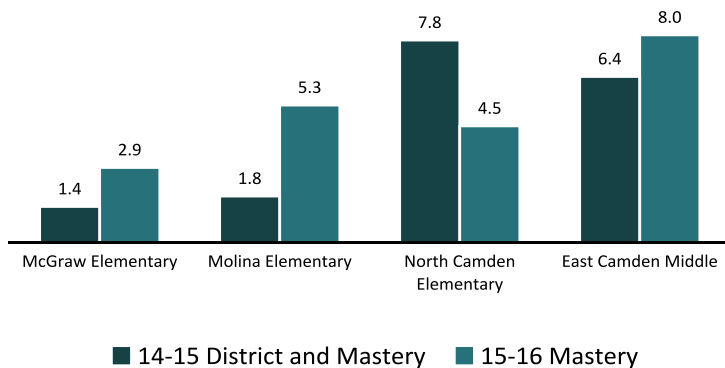

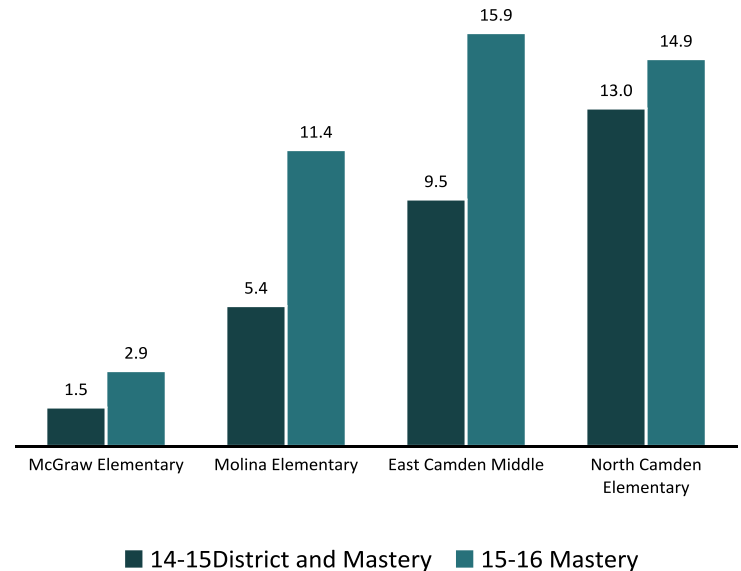
Mastery: Proficiency

ELA – Same students



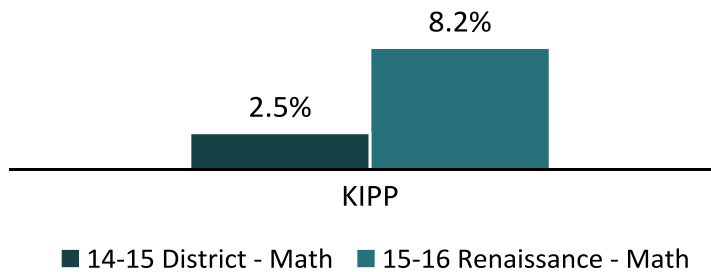
* 377 Mastery students took the math exam, and 375 Mastery students took the ELA exam.

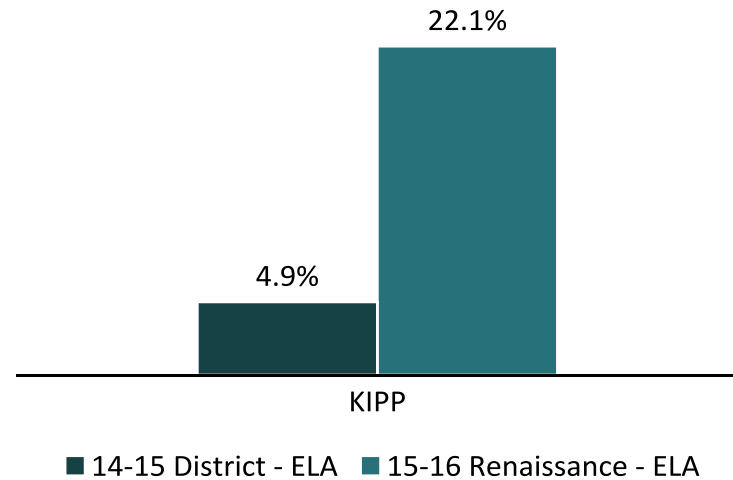
KIPP: Proficiency

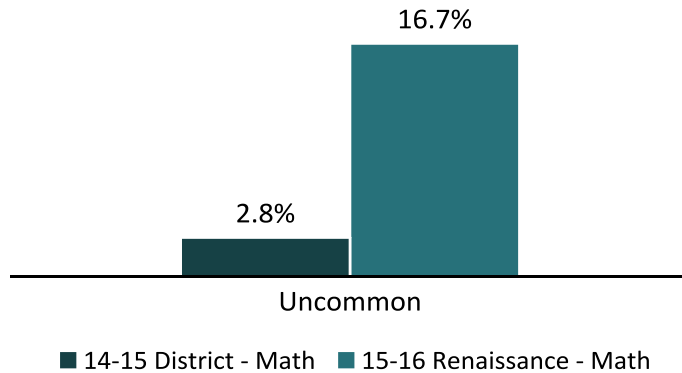
* 122 KIPP students took each exam.

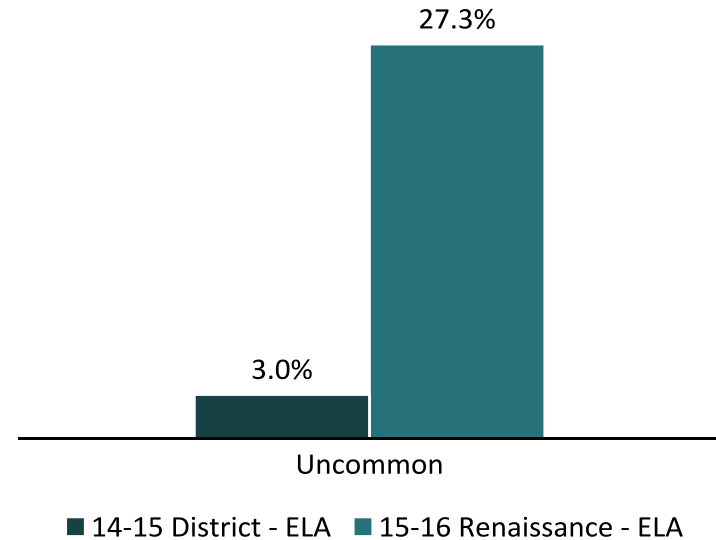
Camden Prep: Proficiency
