Non-Resident Tuition FAQs

Q: Is there an application process for non-resident tuition students?

A: Yes, the application can be found on our school website under the “Community” tab. When the application is completed, the student and their family will have an interview with the school principal.

Q: What grades will be accepting non-resident student applicants?

A: All grades, as long as seats are available.

Q: What is the cost of tuition for a non-resident student?

A: Non-resident tuition is 25% of the annual certified tuition rate. As such, it is subject to change each academic year. The approved tuition rates for the 2022-2023 school year are as follows:

- Kindergarten: \$4,570
- Grades 1-5: \$4,370
- Grades 6-8: \$4,084
- Grades 9-12: \$4,632

Q: If a parent/guardian is unable to afford the tuition rate for the requested school, is there an opportunity to request a waiver of the tuition amount or a reduced amount?

A: Yes, parents/guardians may submit a request for a reduced tuition amount or a complete waiver of the tuition amount upon a showing of financial hardship.

Q: Are non-resident students responsible for their own transportation?

A: Yes.

Q: Will students with special talents in extracurricular activities get preferential acceptance status?

A: No.



Q: How will CCSD determine who gets accepted if the number of applicants is greater than the number of available seats?

A: If the number of applicants exceeds the available number of seats, CCSD will hold a lottery to determine who is accepted.

Q: Are non-resident students able to participate in all school activities?

A: Yes.

Q: Are non-resident students able to participate in school athletic programs?

A: In grades K-8, students may participate in all athletic activities without restriction. In grades 9-12, students may participate in athletics in accordance with NJSIAA rules and guidelines.
